


GETTING STARTED


Capture[®] consists of two main parts – the quick-release plate and the clip. Both are made from die-cast, post-machined powder coated aluminum. All parts are weatherproof and have a lifetime guarantee.





INSTALL THE PLATE Remove the quick-release plate from the clip by pressing the

quick-release button. Install the plate onto the tripod mount on the bottom of your camera. Screw the plate in with a coin or screwdriver, twisting it tight to ensure a solid connection.









unclamp the plates and swivel them apart. **WEAR THE CLIP**




